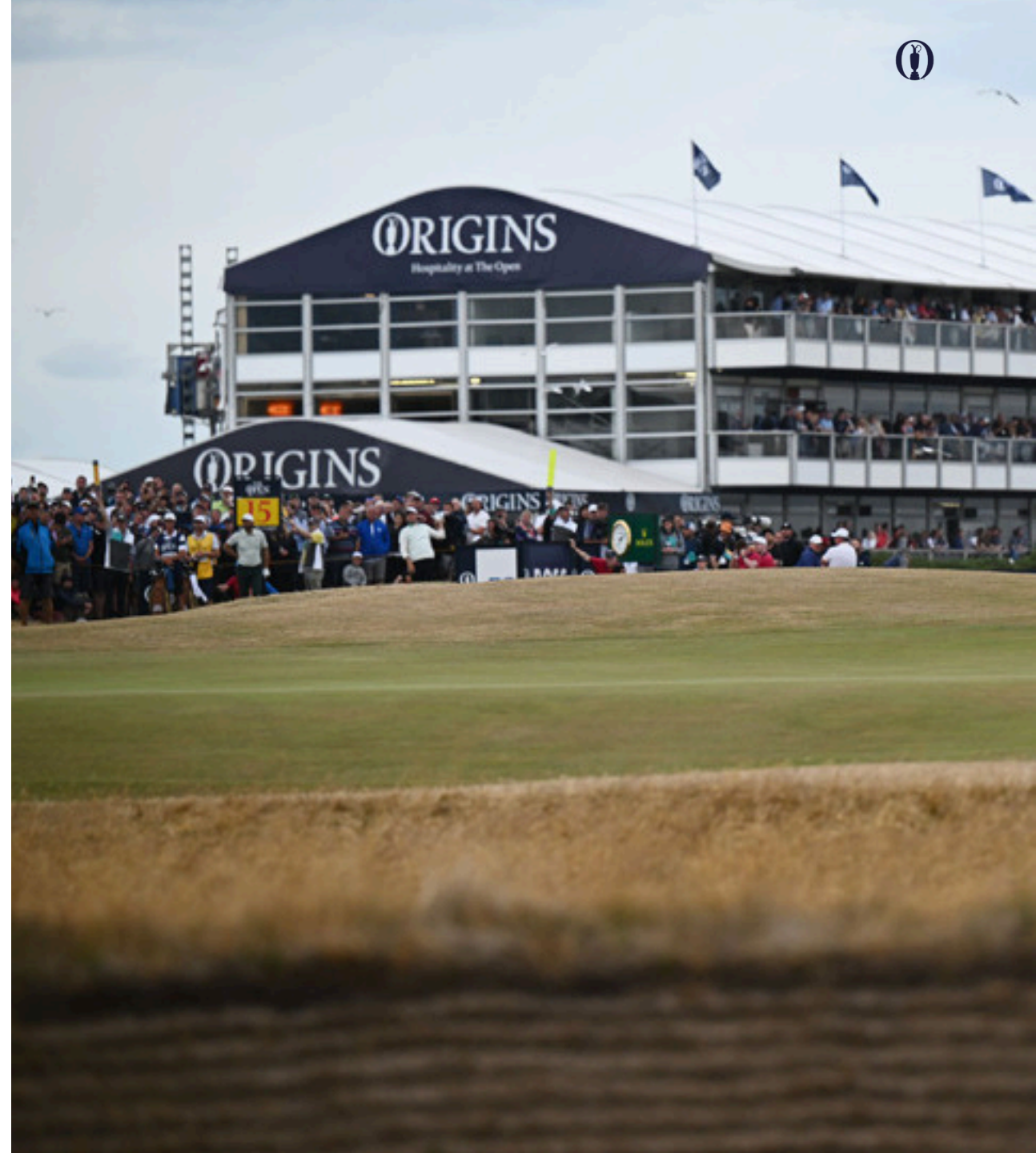

Scorers is a stylish introduction to sporting hospitality at The Open. Guests have the opportunity to soak up all the action in a fun, festival style atmosphere.

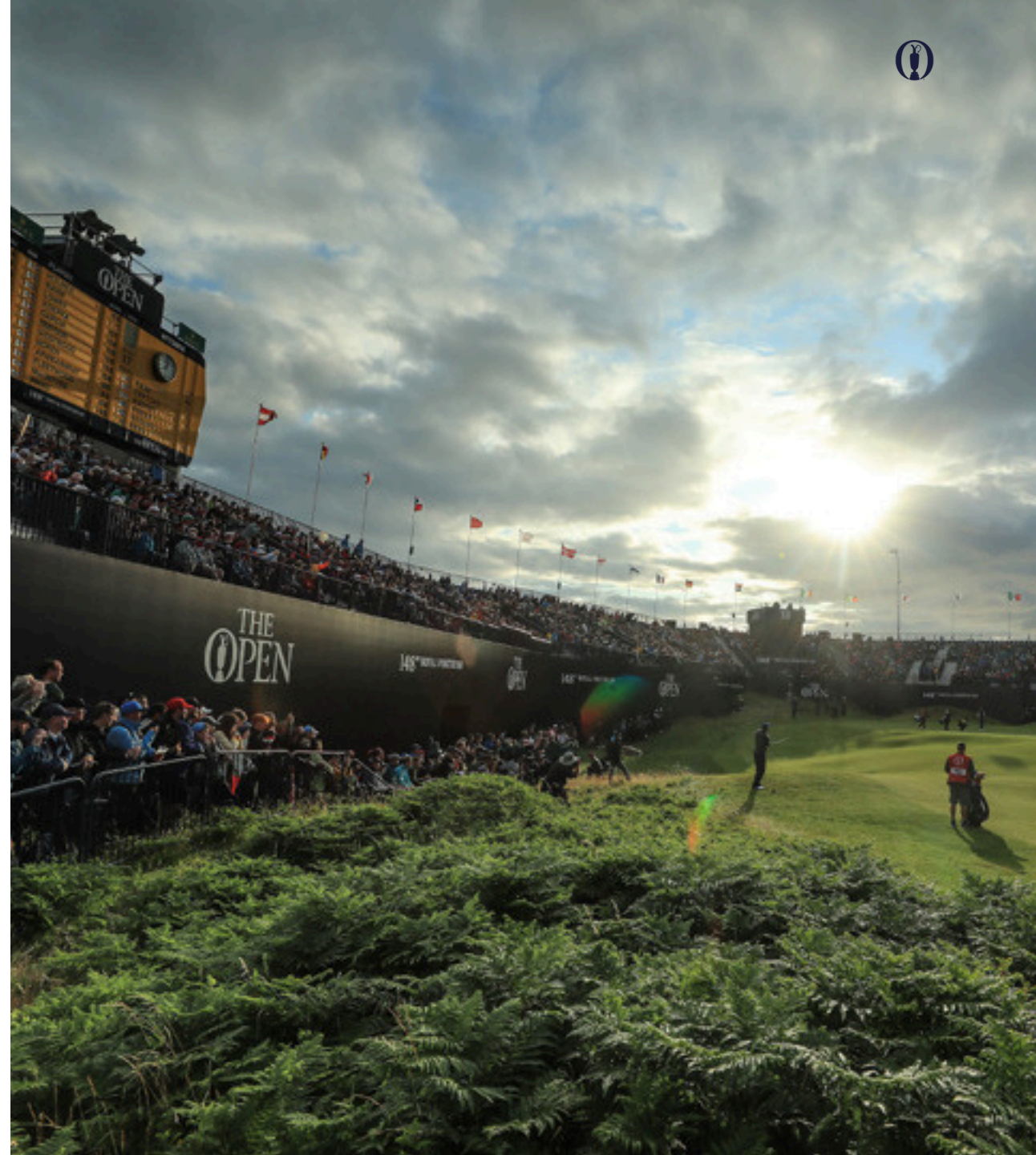
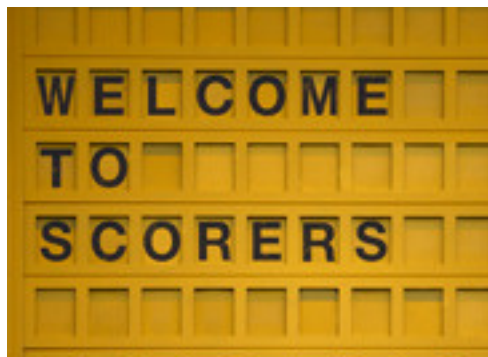
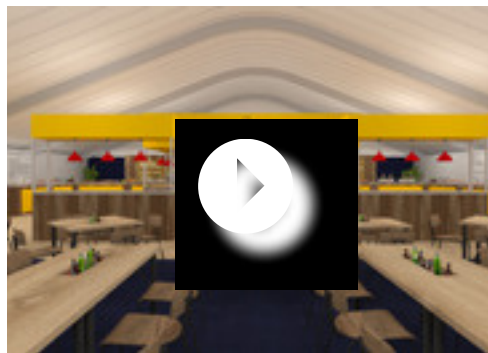

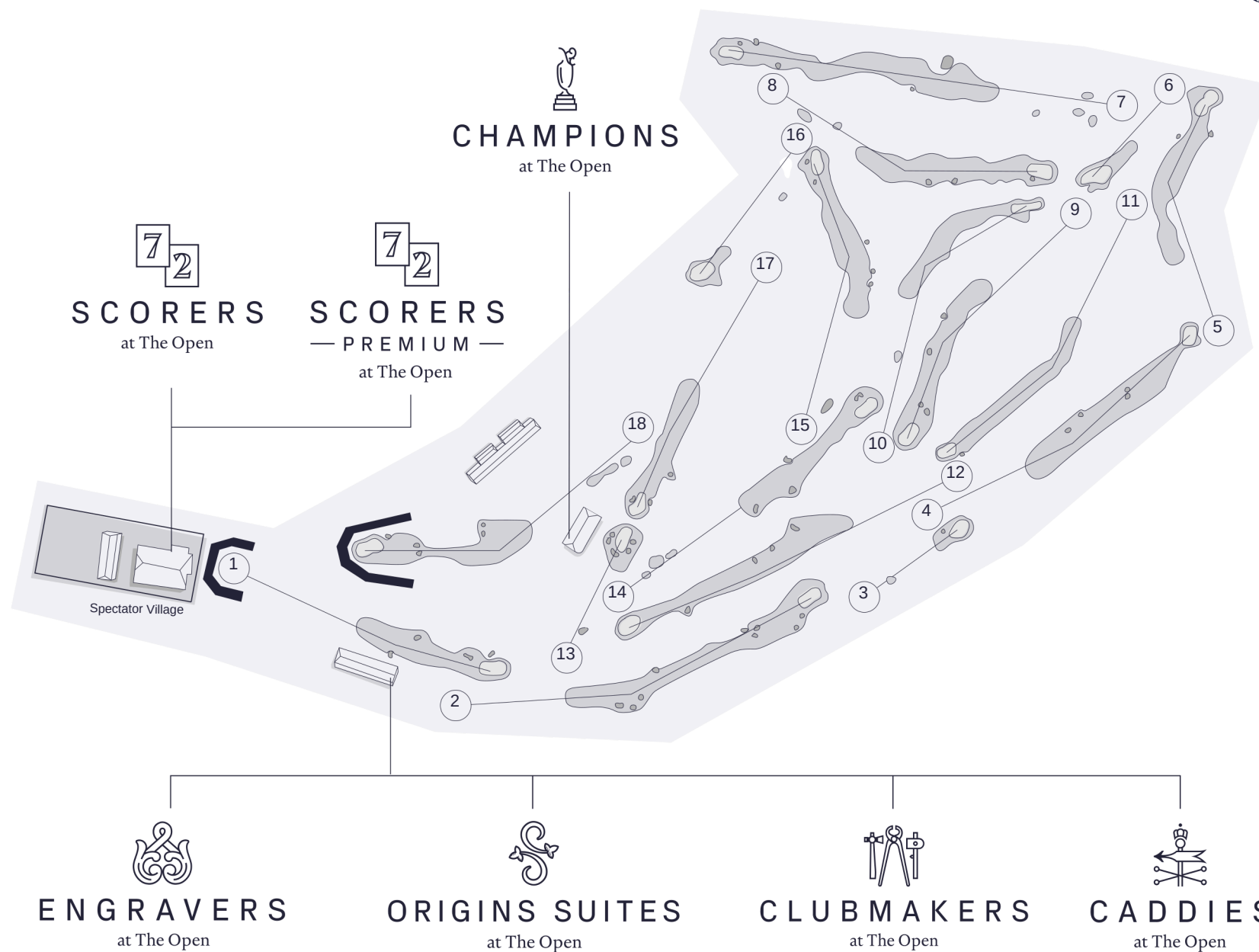
Right at the heart of the course, guests are spectacularly situated next to the 13th green. Enjoy world-class hospitality while soaking in all the action.
