2024 AUTUMN NATIONS SERIES

The 2024 Autumn Nations Series kicks off with Ireland's first ever game on a Friday night at the Aviva Stadium when New Zealand come to Dublin on 8th November. This rivalry has become one of the most exciting in the sport, with Ireland now seeking revenge for the quarter-final defeat at the hands of the All Blacks during the 2023 Rugby World Cup.

Ireland then take on Argentina a week later, again under lights on Friday, 15th November. Los Pumas will bring a tough test for Andy Farrell's side, who have beaten the All Blacks and Australia in recent seasons.

Finally, Ireland mark their 150th season with a special fixture against Australia on Saturday, 30th November. This game will see Wallabies coach Joe Schmidt back in Dublin, it is also Andy Farrell's final game in charge before he takes a sabbatical to coach the British & Irish Lions who tour Australia in the summer of 2025.



Ireland go into the 2025 Guinness Six Nations as back-to-back champions and will look to become the first Irish team in history to win three tournaments in a row.





2025 GUINNESS SIX NATIONS

As far as opening games go, it doesn't get much bigger for Ireland as they welcome England to the Aviva Stadium on Saturday 1st February 2025. While Ireland won the championship, England were the only team to beat them in 2024 with a last second drop goal sealing it in Twickenham.

Irelands second home game of the championship comes against France on 8th March 2025. Les Blues came 2nd in 2024 and will be looking to improve on that position given the strength within their squad, led by the likes of Antoine Dupont and Gregory Alldritt.

HAVELOCK RESTAURANT

The Havelock Restaurant is located on level 4 (executive level) inside the stadium and is our prime hospitality offering. This restaurant is glass fronted and boasts panoramic views of the pitch, the stadium and of Lansdowne Road. This facility is located behind the south goal and reserved padded match seats are located directly outside the room. Tables of 8, 10, 12 and 18 apply. Smaller groups are required to share a table.



VAVASOUR WEST

The Vavasour West Room is located on level 2 inside the stadium and is glass fronted overlooking Lansdowne Road. This room has a capacity of 100 guests and the match tickets are located in the West Upper Stand, Block 524. Private tables of 10 or 12 apply with small groups being catered for on shared tables.







VAVASOUR EAST

The Vavasour East Room is located on level 2 inside the stadium and is glass fronted overlooking Lansdowne Road. This room has a capacity of 100 guests and the match tickets are located in the East Lower Stand, Block 103/106/107. Private tables of 10 or 12 apply with small groups being catered for on shared tables.




MARIAN COLLEGE MARQUEE

The Marian College Marquee is located on Lansdowne Road inside the grounds of Marian College School which is less than a five minute walk to the entrance of Aviva Stadium. The facility is a glass fronted, solid sided marquee structure with a capacity for 900 guests on tables of 10 & 12. The match tickets for the marquee are in the East Stand Lower Blocks 103, 106 & 107 or West Stand Upper Block 527.
